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CONDITIONAL COLUMNS: CASE WHEN

tips tip > 5 THEN 'large' ELSE 'regular' END AS tip_type	<code>tips .assign(tip_type = tips['tip'] .apply(lambda tip: 'large' if tip > 5 else 'regular')) ['tip_type']</code>
tips tip > 5 THEN 'large' WHEN tip < 1 THEN 'small' 	<code>tips .assign(tip_type = tips['tip'] .apply(lambda tip: 'large' if tip > 5 else ('small' if tip < 1 else 'regular'))) ['tip_type']</code>

CALCULATED COLUMNS: *, -, +, /

tip/total_bill AS tip_rate	<code>tips .assign(tip_rate = tips['tip']/tips['total_bill']) ['tip_rate']</code>
